Ninety-six Travelers and guests enjoyed the beautiful fall weather. The targets were definitely “Travelers Tough”. Even the “easy” birds had a trick up their sleeves, going into transition just as they arrived at the sweet spot.

Station eight was a toughie. First bird quartered away low and fast from the left, followed by a high arching chandelle, also from the left.

Station eleven was fun. The first bird was inspired by NASA. Heading right over that tall tree right in front. You could take at the top, where it was tiny, or wait for it to fall toward you, showing more face. Choose your poison! Not being a fan of falling birds, I tightened up and managed to hit it at the top every time (pats self on back).

Station thirteen was also high on the difficulty scale. First bird was a fast chandelle from the left a good distance out, followed by one quartering out fast from the right.

Congratulations to Mark Baltazar, who was HOA with a 90.

Class 2 went to Fred Tucci (86). Class 3 Douglas Roberge (78).
Class 4 Anthony Regelski (78) and Class 5 Ryan Smith (65).

and Vet2 high was Charlie Szabo.

Median scores for each class were: 1 - 79; 2 - 76; 3 - 65; 4 - 50; 5 - 45.

Median score for all shooters was 67, 2 birds less than our average this year

NOVEMBER SHOOT LOGISTICS

We travel to Mid-Hudson Sporting Clays on Sunday, November 20th for our first ever "Potpourri Party".

What is a Potpourri Party? It's a little bit of this and a little bit of that thrown in together.

The signature event will be 100 Super Sporting targets on a shotgun start at 9:30. This will be a squadded event and will be NSCA Registered.

If Super Sporting is not your thing, we will also be running the Small Gauge Championships. The small gauge will be a 50 target course with different targets for each gauge (12, 20, 28, .410). The 50 bird 12 gauge is NSCA Registered, the 20/28/.410 events are not. A competitor can win in any gauge and can win multiple gauges.

Shoot whatever you want; all the subs, only a couple subs, Super Sporting, 12 Gauge 50 bird, or whatever you can fit in by 2:00PM. Lunch for anybody shooting 100 targets.

Participation in our Small Gauge Championships has been declining in recent history. We're trying something different by giving you the opportunity to shoot a mix of events.
